What is your name?

Visualize a place in your community that makes you feel safe, relaxed and happy.

Please share out loud or in the chat.

20 MINUTES

Artist/Youth or host share a story, meditation or inspirational quote

Round One - 15 MINUTES

Guiding questions/statements:

- What do you love or appreciate about your neighborhood or community?
- What issues are currently impacting you, your family or community?

Round Two - 15 MINUTES

• What would you like to envision for the future of your neighborhood and Los Angeles?

Open Discussion

15 MINUTES

Survey
5 MINUTES

Each person shares a thought to leave with the group

5 MINUTES

Next Steps - 5 MINUTES

Facilitator ensures the following points covered:

- 1. We aim to create a safe and welcome all who have joined today to share their stories and to hear the stories of others
- 2. Please be mindful of time, so that all participants have an opportunity to speak to each question and enjoy!
- 3. What happens next creating art to share the stories
